A little about the role:

Following completion of orientation, you will have the opportunity to shadow our experienced psychologists before being allocated clients of your own. The role entails seeing clients in the clinic 2 to 3 days each week which leaves two full admin/report writing days which most of our psychologists choose to do from home. We understand adult learning and development and have carefully constructed a scope and sequence of competency development as you progress through the two-year graduate program. By the end of the graduate program you will have developed competency in providing assessments and interventions across the lifespan, assessing and supporting a range of neurodevelopmental differences including ADHD, autism, SLDs, giftedness and social/emotional difficulties, running groups, and presenting to key stakeholders (i.e. schools/parents).

Who we are looking for

We are looking for graduate psychologists who have a genuine interest in private practice and educational and developmental psychology. You must be ready to be challenged, to provide a high level of care and expertise to clients, and to contribute enthusiastically to our team culture. Successful psychologists will be based at our Heatherton or Moonee Ponds clinic. Travel to regional outreach locations a few times a year is also required.

- Permanent full-time two-year position, with opportunity for ongoing employment following successful completion.
